### Connecting Volunteers to Opportunity

- Added 36 new volunteer programs to our online database
- Hosted 67 organizations at two Volunteer Festivals
- Helped 65 adults with developmental disabilities explore volunteering in our community
- Dispatched Flying Squad volunteers on 208 days of volunteering
- Engaged volunteers to support public health and mental health services with the Fraser Health Authority
- Hosted TriCities Seniors Planning Network, and supported the Seniors Transportation Forum, which attracted 100+ seniors.

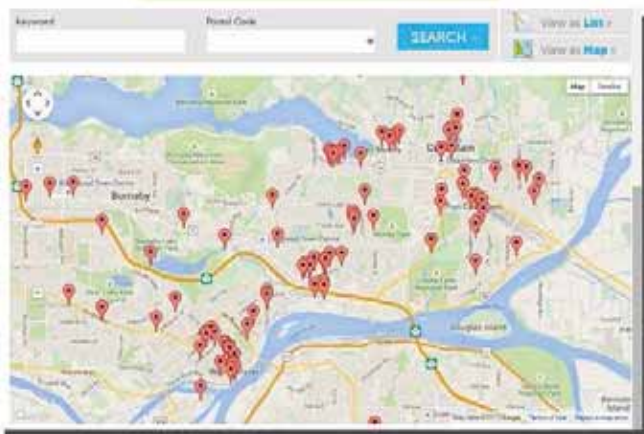
### Training in Volunteer Management

### CVC Flying Squad

Connects busy people, especially youth—to short-term volunteering, when events need extra help. You need help? We come flying!

### Lodge Volunteer Program

Our team of Cottonwood, Connolly and Cypress Lodge volunteers support residents with severe & persistent mental illnesses.

### Public Health Volunteering
